Staying in Touch – Virtually

We have resumed country calls for US partners to share and brainstorm ideas. Our first country call, for US organizations with partners in Tanzania, was held earlier this month via Zoom. Our participating US partners included Gilchrist Hospice, HopeWest, Hospice Services, Inc. and VITAS Innovative Healthcare Connecticut.

Fostering sustainability – both for the African partners and the partnerships themselves – was the driving force for the two topics that garnered the greatest amount of discussion: fundraising and using technology to foster regular communication between partners.

COVID-19 has significantly impacted both domestic and international fundraising and partners discussed ways they've been able to retool their existing fundraising initiatives and brainstormed other approaches.
